Section 2. Account #62-10082-9007 (Program Project Services) was established to cover costs of project management services. Funds in the amount of \$37,000 was transferred from Account #62-13681-9007 (Nikolaevsk Elementary School Contingency) to the new account to cover the cost of these services.
