RESOLUTION 82-85

CLASSIFYING PARCELS OF BOROUGH PATENTED LAND AS PUBLIC USE LAND  
AS SHOWN ON THE PRELIMINARY PLAT OF GRAY CLIFF SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Borough has obtained title to approximately  
5,000 acres of land from the State of Alaska, lying north of  
Captain Cook State Recreation Area within T9N R9W, S.M.; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has authorized the Administration to  
provide for the disposal of these lands to the general public at  
the earliest practicable time; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has contracted for the subdivision of  
these lands; and

WHEREAS, a transportation corridor and certain parcels of  
land have been recommended for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District, North  
Peninsula Recreation Service Area, Nikiski Fire Service Area, and  
the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area boards have requested  
certain parcels be retained for public use; and


WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at its April 19, 1982  
meeting reviewed and recommends that these parcels be retained  
for public use;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Tracts A through X and Lots 190, 216-218,  
250, 251, 252, 267, 268, 336, 337, 338, 339, 340, 388 and Lot 400  
as shown on the preliminary plat of Gray Cliff Subdivision be  
retained under Borough ownership and classified as public use  
lands.

Section 2. That this resolution and takes effect upon its  
adoption.
