RESOLUTION 82-92

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF R & M CONSULTANTS TO DO PRELIMINARY SOILS INVESTIGATIONS ON THREE PARCELS OF BOROUGH LAND AND FEDERAL MOOSE RANGE LAND.

WHEREAS, a segment of the public has expressed a desire to have the existing special waste site relocated; and

WHEREAS, the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service in conjunction with Borough representatives have identified three potential sites for said relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has solicited proposals for the preliminary soils exploration of each of the proposed sites; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds have been budgeted and assigned for the possible relocation of the special waste site;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The proposal of R & M Consultants (Spring 1982) is accepted to perform preliminary soils investigations on the parcels: N $\frac{1}{2}$, plus E $\frac{1}{2}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, plus W $\frac{1}{2}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, T3N R11W, S.M.; S $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 33, T5N R9W, S.M.; plus NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, plus NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, T4N R9W, S.M.; Section 5 and Section 6, T5N R7W, S.M.; and a contract is authorized in terms and conditions which will describe the scope of the work and insure performance of the contractor. Additionally, the scope of work of the soils exploration shall be increased by the addition of two test holes to be located in Sections 21 and 22, T5N R7W, S.M.

Section 2. That the total cost of this shall not exceed \$40,000, and funds for this project are transferred from Account #65-29181-9007 (Sterling Special Waste Relocation Contingency) to Account #65-29181-9214 (Sterling Special Waste Relocation Soils) for the expense of this contract.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
