RESOLUTION 82-98

AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC UTILITY RELOCATION AGREEMENT WITH
GLACIER STATE TELEPHONE COMPANY FOR THE HOLT ROAD
CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough proposes to construct or
reconstruct and improve a portion of the highway known as
Holt Road from the centerline of Miller Loop Road to
Station 128 in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the road construction project requires the
adjustment or relocation of certain telephone utility
facilities within the proposed right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department and the Glacier
State Telephone Company have negotiated a mutually
satisfactory arrangement for the utility relocation in
conjunction with the construction project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into
an agreement with Glacier State Telephone Company to provide
for the relocation of public utility telephone facilities
located within the right-of-way of Holt Road and which
require relocation in connection with the construction of
the road project. The agreement shall be in such terms and
conditions as will protect the interests of the Borough.
The costs shall not, in any event, exceed a relocation cost
of \$18,461, and shall be charged to the Holt Road
Constuction Account No. 065.21038.9210.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the
date of its adoption.
