KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-1

SUPPORTING A DIRECT GRANT FROM THE STATE LEGISLATURE FOR THE RETIREMENT OF THE BEAR CREEK FIRE SERVICE AREA DEBT.

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area has a debt of \$130,000 on its fire station; and

WHEREAS, due to the low assessed value of the Bear Creek Fire Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the assessed value of the Service Area decreased substantially due to the removal of a pipe yard; and

WHEREAS, the mill rate for fire service in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area is just under that of the City of Seward for all services; and


WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Board of Directors Resolution #4 - 82 requests the Borough to adopt a resolution requesting a special appropriation for the tax relief;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a sum of money in the amount of \$130,000 for Bear Creek debt service retirement be granted by the First Session, Thirteenth Legislature of the State of Alaska to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the purpose of retiring such debt service.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
