KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-8

ESTABLISHING THE OFFICIAL POPULATION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH AT 32,303 PERSONS.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that an official determination of population in the Borough be made annually for use in the State and Federal Revenue Sharing program grant applications, for community brochures information, for dues to the Alaska Municipal League, and for other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough conducted a 1982 census under the procedures set forth in the Alaska Census Administrator's Manual and the Alaska Census Enumerator's Manual, which are in accordance with concepts and definitions used by the U.S. Bureau of Census;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly accepts this 1982 certified census count and declares the population of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to be 32,303 persons.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
