KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 83-101 (SUBSTITUTE)

AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT (PHASE IA) WITH ROY F. WESTON, INC., FOR THE CENTRAL PENINSULA INCINERATION FACILITY PROJECT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED COST OF \$39,000.

WHEREAS, the Assembly by Resolution 83-17 authorized \$25,000 of Municipal Aid Grant Funds for an engineering investigations and evaluation as to the feasibility of a Central Peninsula Incineration Facility; and

WHEREAS, a review of the nature of the project, and the time schedule for State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, indicates the need for an increase in the scope of Professional Services; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has advertised and received proposals for engineering services on said project; and

WHEREAS, both the Professional Review Team and the Public Works Department have identified Roy F. Weston, Inc., as having submitted the best proposal for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has recommended the award of a contract for Professional Services with Roy F. Weston, Inc., for Phase I of the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a contract is authorized to be awarded to Roy F. Weston, Inc., to provide engineering services for Phase IA of the Central Peninsula Incineration Facility Project in an amount not to exceed \$39,000 to be administered from the following accounts in the amounts as noted:

Section 2. That the Assembly authorizes the transfer of \$15,000 from the Federal Revenue Sharing for Solid Waste Account
