RESOLUTION 83-103

SETTING THE DATE FOR THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION HEARINGS AND THE DATES WHEN TAXES ARE PAYABLE AND DELINQUENT.

WHEREAS, the Borough Assessor has prepared and mailed assessment notices of valuations of taxable properties for the assessment and tax roll for the tax year 1983; and

WHEREAS, the taxpayers have a right to appeal the valuations to the Assembly sitting as the Board of Equalization;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly, sitting as the Board of Equalization, shall meet on May 10, 1983, at 6:00 p.m., in the Assembly Room of the Borough Administration Building, Binkley and Park Streets, Soldotna, Alaska. The meetings may be adjourned from time to time or continued at such times and places designated by the President of the Assembly until all appeals have been heard.

Section 2. The Borough's general property taxes for 1983 may be paid in two installments. The first installment is due on August 15, 1983, and if not paid when due, the entire tax becomes delinquent, and penalty and interest will accrue as provided by law. The second installment is due on November 15, 1983, and is delinquent after that date.
