RESOLUTION 83-124

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,945,600 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE STERLING ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION AND RENOVATION PROJECT TO H2W CONSTRUCTORS, INC.

WHEREAS, the Borough has solicited and opened bids for the construction of the Sterling Elementary School project; and

WHEREAS, architectural design plans have been approved by the Borough Assembly Resolution 83-133 and 83-5; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds will be available upon sale and delivery of 1982 bonds for this project, and the Dept. of Public Works has recommended that the contract be awarded,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the bid of H2W Constructors, Inc. to perform all work required by the Sterling Elementary School Addition and Renovation for the base bid of \$1,884,000 plus Alternate No. 1 for \$61,600 is accepted and that a contract for this work in the total amount of \$1,945,600 is authorized. All expenditures for this work shall be charged to the Sterling Elementary School account number 062-17882-9010.

Section 2. That the award of this contract is contingent upon the sale of the 1982 School Bonds, and no Notice to Proceed shall be issued until these bonds have been sold and delivered.
