RESOLUTION 83-134

ALLOCATING PROPORTIONATE SHARES OF \$105,000 FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUNDS TO SENIOR CITIZENS ORGANIZATIONS.

WHEREAS, the assembly has appropriated \$105,000 for use by senior citizens' organizations within the Borough and that the pro rata share be fixed at 25% of the projected revenue sharing funds; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that each of the five senior citizens' organizations within the Borough will receive a pro rata share based on the 1980 census with applicability to senior citizens 60 years of age and over per the federal and state guidelines; and

WHEREAS, senior citizen population has been determined to be approximately the same percentage of the total population of each area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The following amounts shall be distributed based on a flat share and a percentage of the population in each area as compared with the population of all areas:
