KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-141

AUTHORIZING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE KENAI-KASILOF SOIL CONSERVATION SUB-DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Kenai-Kasilof Soil Conservation Subdistrict has been established under the authority of AS 41.10; and

WHEREAS, the Subdistrict has the responsibility for encouraging the active interest of landowners, operators and the public and informing them of the necessity and methods for achieving resource conservation objectives; and

WHEREAS, the Subdistrict is charged with developing a long-range program and an annual work plan pertaining to the conservation and management of renewable natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has the responsibility for coordinating planning activities affecting land uses with the Borough to assure a coordinated comprehensive plan for the entire Borough; and

WHEREAS, it would be mutually beneficial for the Borough and Subdistrict to enter into cooperative agreements in order to coordinate Subdistrict programs with other affected units of local government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough agrees to assist with education and information programs designed to make the public aware of the need for the proper use and development of natural resources.

Section 2. That the Borough keep the Subdistrict informed on planning and development proposals that affect conservation of soil, water, wildlife and related natural resources.

Section 3. That the Borough recognizes the Subdistrict's Natural Resource Conservation Program as official input to the comprehensive planning process and to give appropriate consideration to the objectives and policies contained therein for inclusion in the Borough Comprehensive Plan.

Section 4. That the Borough recognize the Subdistrict's Annual Work Program as the implementing mechanism for appropriate Natural Resource Conservation Program objectives and policies which have been included in the comprehensive plan.

Section 5. That the Borough recognize the Subdistrict as the local leader in matters pertaining to the planning and management of renewable natural resources.

Section 6. That the Borough consider, and as appropriate, provide fiscal resources to support Subdistrict activities of benefit to the Borough.


Section 7. That the Borough consider, and as appropriate, provide fiscal support and coordination to assist the Subdistrict to comply with requirements of statewide planning goals.

Section 8. That the Borough Mayor is authorized to execute such documents deemed necessary to effectuate this resolution and to be in the best interests of the Borough.
