KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-143

APPROVING RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION ON CERTAIN PROPOSED STATE LEGISLATION.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Resource Development Commission has been established for the purposes of advising the Borough Assembly on matters relating to the general economic condition of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Development Commission, in its carrying out this charge, conducted a review of pending State legislation and has determined the following legislative bills as being in the best interests of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and the State of Alaska and has recommended support by the Assembly:

Senate Bill 21 - An Act relating to grants for water supply, sewerage and solid waste facilities;

Senate Bill 44 - An Act relating to the development of small farms;

House Bill 26 - An Act establishing the business refinancing and expansion loan program in the Alaska Industrial Development Authority;

House Bill 57 - An Act establishing the Alaska State Housing Authority Home Mortgage program;

House Bill 148 - An Act relating to the preservation of agricultural land;

House Bill 234 - An Act making a special appropriation...for distribution of additional salmon enhancement tax receipts to the Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined the following legislation as not being in the best interests of the Borough and State and recommends opposition by the Assembly:

Senate Bill 45 - An Act transferring administration of the Agricultural Revolving Loan Fund to the Alaska Agricultural Action Council; and

House Bill 22 - An Act establishing a state residency requirement for loans purchased by the Alaska Industrial Development Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Senate Bills 21 and 44, and House Bills 22, 26, 57, 148 and 234 are hereby endorsed; and

Section 2. That Senate Bill 45 and House Bill 22 are opposed; and

Section 3. That copies of this resolution be forwarded to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to Representatives Betty Cato, Milo Fritz and Hugh Malone, and to appropriate committee chairmen in the State Senate and House of Representatives.
