RESOLUTION 83-146

APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS FOR THE NEW HOMER HIGH SCHOOL PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING C.T.A. ARCHITECTS TO PROCEED WITH THE BIDDING PHASE.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has previously approved the preparation of construction documents for the New Homer High School project by C.T.A. Architects; and

WHEREAS, these documents have been completed and the Assembly approves the scope of the project outlined in the construction documents; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to proceed with the bidding phase and final construction of the New Homer High School project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That construction documents for the New Homer High School project, prepared by C.T.A. Architects are approved subject to the review and approval of the Board of Education, and that the Assembly approves the proposed scope and nature of the project outlined in the construction documents.

Section 2. That the award of a construction contract by the assembly will be limited to the scope of work approved for debt retirement by the State Department of Education unless the Add Alternates are approved by the assembly.

Section 3. That the architect is authorized to proceed with the bidding phase.
