RESOLUTION 83-152

AMENDING THE PROCUREMENT PURCHASING POLICY ADOPTED IN RESOLUTION 77-5 AS AMENDED BY RESOLUTION 81-209.

WHEREAS, the Assembly adopted procurement purchasing policy in Resolution 77-5, adopted February 15, 1977; and

WHEREAS, that policy was amended in part by Resolution 81-209, adopted December 15, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the current policy requires all projects in an amount greater than \$10,000 to be awarded through formal competitive bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the planning of projects and incorporation of projects into larger units can inure to the benefit of the taxpayers by taking of advantage of cost factors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the fourth paragraph of Section 1 of the Procurement and Purchasing Policy adopted by Resolution 77-5 and as amended by Resolution 81-209 is amended to read:

Formal competitive bidding procedures will be used for all expenditures for services, supplies, and contracts in excess of \$15,000. Splitting the amount of the expenditures for the purpose of avoiding the formal bid procedure is a direct violation of this policy; provided however, that the division of the project, engineering, and planning and fiscally sound phases to take advantage of price factors, construction schedules, construction seasons, labor supply, product availability, etc., is not a violation of this policy.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
