KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-184

GRANTING AN EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC ACCESS AND UTILITY EASEMENTS ACROSS BOROUGH LANDS WITHIN SEC. 1, T4N, R11W, S.M., AND EAST OF WASHINGTON DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the Borough has received patent and final approval of certain Borough selected lands; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a request for a utility easement from Homer Electric Association; and

WHEREAS, it is logical to dedicate a 40 foot right-of-way for public access and utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the request at its meeting August 22, 1983 and recommended approval;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That an easement for public access and utility purposes is granted on the lands described as:

The westerly 40 feet of the $W\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T4N, R11W, S.M.

The utility easement is restricted to the easterly 20 foot of the designated easement.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents deemed necessary to effectuate this resolution and in the best interests of the Borough.
