A RESOLUTION NAMING THE TRACK AT THE HOMER MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL
"THE DAVE SCHROER TRACK."

WHEREAS, for many years Dave Schroer has been an active
and valued member of the Homer community; and

WHEREAS, Dave Schroer has retired after rendering 25
years of service to the school children of Homer as a teacher
in the Homer Middle School; and

WHEREAS, Dave Schroer has actively contributed to the
athletic and recreational activities of the youth of Homer
through his position as coach in that school; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Kenai Peninsula
Borough School District has recommended that the Borough
Assembly honor Dave Schroer for his many years of service to
the youth of Homer by naming the track at the Homer Middle/High
School "The Dave Schroer Track"; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough deems
it entirely fitting that Dave Schroer be commemorated for his
long years of service;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That in commemoration of 25 years of service
as teacher and coach to the youth of Homer in the Homer Middle
School, the track at the Homer Middle/High School is hereby
named "The Dave Schroer Track."

Section 2. That copies of this resolution will be
delivered to the Superintendent of Schools to be presented to
the School Board of the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District
for such distribution as the School Board may deem fitting.
