KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-199 (Substitute)

AUTHORIZING THE RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN PROGRAMS BY VARIOUS COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS IN THE DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION CONCERNING THE OUTSTANDING QUALITIES AND RESOURCES OF THE BOROUGH AND TO SPEND UP TO \$8,000 IN ASSISTING AND SUPPORTING SUCH PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula has a wide variety of quality recreational, cultural and educational opportunities which offer potential business, industry and residents a quality of life unmatched elsewhere in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the quality of life available to its employees is a major consideration of business or government in its decision where to locate new facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Development Commission has determined it to be in the best interest of the Borough and its industrial development efforts to direct public attention to the outstanding opportunities and resources of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, funds have been budgeted to accomplish such goals;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Resource Development Commission is authorized to participate in programs by various community organizations to disseminate information concerning the opportunities and resources of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and is authorized to spend up to \$8,000 of previously budgeted funds to assist or participate in such programs.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately on the date of its adoption.
