KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-20

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FOR CONSTRUCTION AND DESIGN FUNDS OF CERTAIN STATE MAINTAINED ROADS WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, the major collector roads within the Borough are currently maintained by the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the majority of these roads serve areas of significant population density and are in need of frequent maintenance, and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that it is desirable to pave certain major collector roads so as to minimize the need for frequent maintenance due to high traffic volumes, and to provide better and more convenient access to the land lying along these major collectors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly adopts and endorses the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Road Program published by the Kenai Peninsula Borough's Department of Public Works dated January 1983.

Section 2. That the Assembly urges the State Legislature to appropriate the "full" construction funding request of \$26.35 million for the list of roads identified in the road program.

Section 3. That the Assembly urges the Legislature to appropriate the amount of \$1,020,000 for the design of future road projects as identified in the road program.

Section 4. That the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senate President Jalmar M. Kertulla, to House Speaker Joe L. Hayes, to Senators Donald E. Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette M. Cato, and Milo Fritz.
