KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-200

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,400 TO THE HOMER AND KENAI/KASILOF SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICTS TO EVALUATE AND ASSESS THE AGRICULTURAL SUITABILITY OF BOROUGH LANDS AND THE EXPENDITURE OF RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION FUNDS FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, recent public hearings by the Borough Assembly's Lands Committee identified significant interest among Borough residents in lands being made available for agricultural development; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has in its possession tracts of land considered suitable for agricultural development; and

WHEREAS, the development of agriculture is to be considered of benefit to the economy and well being of the Borough and its residents; and

WHEREAS, there is need for the Borough to inventory and evaluate its land holdings to determine which lands are most suitable for agricultural use before there is consideration on whether any lands are made available for agricultural purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Development Commission has gone on record in support of making Borough lands available for agricultural purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Development Commission has requested a proposal for determining the agricultural suitability of Borough lands from the Homer and Kenai/Kasilof Soil and Water Conservation Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Districts have agreed perform the needed land evaluation and site assessment for the total price of \$10,400; and

WHEREAS, the Resource Development Commission recommends that the Borough Assembly approve the Borough entering into the necessary agreement with the Homer and Kenai/Kasilof Soil and Water Conservation Districts to perform an agricultural land evaluation and site assessment on Borough lands.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly authorizes a contract in the amount of \$10,400 to the Homer and Kenai/Kasilof Soil and Water Conservation Districts to evaluate and assess the agricultural suitability of Borough lands.



Section 2. That the Assembly authorizes the expenditure of Resource Development Commission funds for such purpose.
