KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-227 (Amended)

SETTING FORTH REQUESTS OF THE ASSEMBLY FOR LEGISLATIVE ACTION BY THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE AND ESTABLISHING PRIORITIES OF THE BOROUGH ON THESE REQUESTED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Second Session of the Thirteenth Legislature of the State of Alaska will convene in January of 1984; and

WHEREAS, THE Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough finds it in the best interest of the Borough to provide a list of matters of concern to the Borough that require legislative action; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of this list is essential to adequate consideration of request of the Kenai Peninsula Borough for legislative action;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following items are considered to be priorities for action by the Alaska Legislature:

A. Capital Projects Funding (Local Area)

1. For construction of Homer High School Additive Alternates and the additions to Soldotna Jr. High, East Homer Elementary, Port Graham & English Bay schools;
2. For costs of relocating to DOT maintenance yard in Homer to facilitate transferring the property for use with the Homer High School;
3. Local road projects;
4. Solid waste disposal projects;
5. Seward grain terminal completion;

B. Capital Projects Funding (Statewide Issues)


1. Royalty oil contracts;
2. Municipal assistance, revenue sharing, school bond reimbursement & foundation program;

3. Senior citizen residence exemption (full funding);
 4. Local Roads & Trails Program;
 5. Road maintenance at 2500 per mile;
 6. Alaska railroad acquisition;
- C. Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Project
- D. Protection of Kenai River Drainage
- E. Other Legislative Action Needed
1. Repeal of Title 29.48.033, Garbage & solid waste;
 2. Rewrite of Title 13, Fire code concerning schools
 3. Establishment of a Dept. of Transportation office in the Borough;
 4. Additional funding to provide full staffing for full time operation of a Division of Motor Vehicles Office on the Kenai Peninsula.

Section 2. That the Borough Clerk shall distribute a copy of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, Senate President Jalmar Kerttula, to House speaker Joe L. Hayes, to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz, and Vern Hurlbert, and to the Chairs of the Resource and Finance Committees.


Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
