RESOLUTION 83-24

ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF RAYMOND A. GILLESPIE FROM THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY, DECLARING A VACANCY IN ASSEMBLY SEAT B OF DISTRICT I, DIRECTING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF THE VACANCY AND INVITE PETITIONS FOR NOMINATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH KPB 2.16.020, AND COMMENDING RAYMOND A. GILLESPIE FOR HIS SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Raymond A. Gillespie has given notice of his resignation, effective January 14, 1983 from Seat B, District I, of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly by letter to the Borough Clerk dated January 10, 1983; and

WHEREAS, it is highly important to the citizens of District I that this resignation be accepted promptly and procedures initiated immediately to fill this vacancy so that District I can be adequately and fully represented on the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the resignation of Raymond A. Gillespie from Seat B, District I, of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly is hereby accepted.

Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk is hereby directed to take immediate action to give notice of nominations for appointment to fill the vacancy in Assembly Seat B, District I, in accordance with the provisions of KPB 2.16.020.

Section 3. That Raymond A. Gillespie be commended for the services he has rendered to the citizens of his community and district and to the Kenai Peninsula Borough with the expectation that he will be of greater service to the citizens of this Borough, as well as to all the citizens of the State, in the position which he is accepting in the Office of the Governor.
