RESOLUTION 83-29

AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF SOLDOTNA FOR THE 1982 CONSTRUCTION OF ROADWAY LIGHTING UPGRADE.

WHEREAS, the City of Soldotna has in 1982 exchanged mercury lights for sodium lights to improve lighting within the city and to reduce energy costs; and

WHEREAS, this project was accomplished pursuant to a Borough allocation of Local Service Road and Trails money to construction projects within the City of Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, the project has been completed and should be closed out so that the Borough may be reimbursed by the State of Alaska for construction of this project and may, in turn, reimburse the City of Soldotna for the total incurred cost of \$23,140;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly finds that the 1982 upgrading of Roadway Lights has been completed according to specification by the City of Soldotna, and that the Assembly requests the State of Alaska to reimburse the Borough for total costs of \$23,140 incurred in constructing this project.


Section 2. That upon full reimbursement to the Borough by the State of Alaska, the Borough will reimburse the City of Soldotna in the amount of \$23,140 for funds expended by the City.

Section 3. That on receipt of reimbursement from the State of Alaska, the sum of \$23,140 will be transferred from the Unassigned Soldotna City Streets Contingency Account #07-22005-9007 to Roadway Lighting Upgrade Account #07-22007-9210.
