KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-38

REQUESTING A DIRECT GRANT FROM THE STATE LEGISLATURE FOR THE PURCHASE AND REPLACEMENT OF FIRE APPARATUS FOR THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area includes within its boundaries many petroleum plants and refineries, and the fire apparatus needed must have the capability to combat petroleum, chemical, and structural-related fires; and

WHEREAS, the Nikiski structural apparatus is ten years old, and does not meet their total requirements at this time; and

WHEREAS, inadequate equipment to properly fight fires in the petroleum and chemical complexes in the Nikiski area might lead, not only to great loss of life, but also to the complete loss of one of these plants as a practical working plant to the detriment of the Borough and the State tax base and government tax revenues;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a sum of money in the amount of \$400,000 be granted to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the purpose of purchasing fire apparatus for the Nikiski Fire Service Area.

Section 2. That immediately after adoption of this resolution the Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk will distribute copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz and Vern Hurlbert.
