KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-40

REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO RELEASE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH RESERVES NOT ACTUALLY BEING PRESENTLY UTILIZED.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State of Alaska to encourage the settlement of its lands and the development of its resources by making them available for maximum use consistent with the public interests as set forth in Article VIII, Section 1, Constitution of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, there are presently existing many acres of lands classified as agricultural land but reserved for agricultural research which are not being utilized for agricultural research; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Governor and the Commissioner of Natural Resources remove the reservation for agricultural research purposes from those lands which are not presently devoted to actual agricultural research.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough distribute copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senators Donald Gilman and Paul Fischer, to Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz and Vern Hurlbert, and to the Commissioner of Natural Resources.
