APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS FOR THE TUSTUMENA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITIONS AND RENOVATIONS (1983) PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING MCGLOTHLIN BALIVET COMPANY TO PROCEED WITH THE BIDDING PHASE.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has previously approved the preparation of construction documents for the Tustumena Elementary School Additions and Renovations (1983) project by McGlothlin Balivet Company; and

WHEREAS, these documents have been completed and the Assembly approves the scope of the project outlined in the construction documents; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to proceed with the bidding phase and final construction of the Tustumena Elementary School Additions and Renovations (1983) project.,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That construction documents for the Tustumena Elementary School Additions and Renovations (1983) project, prepared by McGlothlin Balivet Company are approved, and that the Assembly approves the proposed scope and nature of the project outlined in the construction documents. This approval is subject to a review of the sizing of the stand-by generator as specified in Add Alternate A. The final determination of generator sizing shall rest with the Borough Administration.

Section 2. That the architect is authorized to proceed with the bidding phase.
