KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-50

SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL NO. 19 AS AMENDED TO PROVIDE FOR FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGE DORMITORIES.

WHEREAS, SB 19, as amended, provides for funding of dormitories on community college campuses, including the Kenai Peninsula Community College; and

WHEREAS, the community college should be available for service to all students on the Peninsula and not just to those in the immediate vicinity of the college campus; and

WHEREAS, during the school year the long nights, icy roads, and the ever threatening possibility of moose on the roads, make a distance of travel to a college dangerous as well as expensive; and


WHEREAS, in view of these circumstances the erection of dormitory complexes on the campus of the Kenai Peninsula Community College would make it more readily and more safely available to the residents of the Kenai Peninsula other than those in the immediate Soldotna-Kenai area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Legislature and the Governor William J. Sheffield be urged to pass SB 19, amended to provide for appropriations for dormitory housing in all community colleges of the State, and particularly community colleges serving a population spread over a large area such as the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That immediately after adoption of this resolution, the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is directed to distribute copies thereof to Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senate President Jalmar Kerttula, to House Speaker Joe L. Hayes, to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to House of Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz, and Vern Hurlbert.
