
WHEREAS, there is an increased awareness by the general population and a desirability for physical fitness; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly hereby requests the Honorable Governor William J. Sheffield and the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation to fund the design, planning, and construction of a scenic bicycle trail commencing at the Captain Cook State Recreation Area and terminating at the Soldotna "Y".
