RESOLUTION 83-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ADOPTING THE TECHNICAL ASPECT AND GRID NUMBERING SYSTEM OF GLACIER STATE TELEPHONE COMPANY IN ORDER TO EXPEDITE EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has experienced a marked increase in growth and development and an increase in various emergency service areas; and

WHEREAS, in order to promote a uniform house numbering and location system, representatives of various utility companies, the Borough Planning Department and Borough Planning Commission and representative's of Nikiski Fire Service Area and other interested people met in May and June of 1979 to formulate such a system; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission on July 10, 1979 adopted the technical aspects and grid numbering system of Glacier State Telephone Co. as the system to be utilized by the Borough when and if it deemed such a system necessary; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to 1979 there have been several more emergency service areas created and with their creation as well as the increased development it has become evident that in order to facilitate and to increase the response time of the emergency services (ambulance, fire, police) it is necessary to have some type of location system; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 1983 this necessity of a location system to expedite the emergency services was presented to the Borough Planning Commission and the Borough Planning Commission took no action to rescind or amend the action of July 9, 1979;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. The Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopts the technical aspects of the location grid and numbering system as presented by Glacier State Telephone Co. as the Borough's official system in the areas served by Glacier State.

Section 2. That this resolution becomes effective upon its adoption.
