APPROVING THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR THE CENTRAL PENINSULA HOSPITAL RELOCATION OF PHYSICAL AND HYDROTHERAPY DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Physical and Hydrotherapy Department has expanded; and

WHEREAS, the present quarters are no longer adequate; and

WHEREAS, the Hospital Board has given serious consideration to relocating this department to the basement; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for this project from the Phase I project; and

WHEREAS, the documents for this project have been completed and presented to the Central Peninsula Hospital Board at their March 10 meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

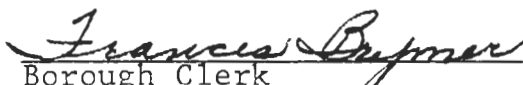
