RESOLUTION 83-60

APPROVING THE STRAIGHT ALIGNMENT ON HALBOUTY ROAD AS THE MOST ADVANTAGEOUS ALIGNMENT.

WHEREAS, three alignments have been proposed as solutions for the entrance to Halbouty Road; and

WHEREAS, the straight alignment is the superior alignment from a traffic safety perspective; and

WHEREAS, the straight alignment is estimated to have the least construction cost; and

WHEREAS, the straight alignment is designed; and

WHEREAS, the straight alignment has no utility relocation problems to complicate the project; and

WHEREAS, this project has had considerable Assembly input and discussion, and the Administration recommends the straight road alignment as the most beneficial from a drafting and engineering viewpoint;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly supports the straight alignment as the superior alignment.

Section 2. That the Assembly requests the Administration to proceed with negotiations with the affected property owners for right-of-way along the straight alignment.
