RESOLUTION 83-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH REQUESTING THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO INSTITUTE A REDUCED SPEED ZONE IN THE AREA OF THE NIKISHKA MALL.

WHEREAS, the area along the North Kenai Road known as the "Nikishka Mall" continues to become more congested with the influx of more businesses and traffic; and

WHEREAS, the topography of the area, as well as the location of the various business access driveways creates a hazardous situation for motorists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, repeated efforts on the part of private citizens, and on the part of the Borough Administration to get a speed limit reduction, have failed to realize a positive response from the State Department of Transportation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests that the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities institute a 45 mile per hour speed zone on the Kenai Spur Road between Mile 26.2 and Mile 27.2.

Section 2. That a copy of this resolution be mailed to Governor William J. Sheffield; to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer; to Representative Bette Cato; to Captain C. E. Swackhammer, Alaska State Troopers; to Commissioner Daniel A. Casey, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities; and to Keith Morberg, Highway Engineering Chief, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
