KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-78

SUPPORTING ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL NO. 120 AMENDING ALASKA STATUTES AS 41.10 PROVIDING FOR INCREASING THE MEMBERS OF THE ALASKA SOIL CONSERVATION BOARD AND INCLUDING WATER CONSERVATION WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION AND REDEFINING JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska was previously a single soil conservation district administered by only three board members; and

WHEREAS, the previous board did not adequately represent the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, water was not previously included as a resource to be managed; and

WHEREAS, SB 120 would provide for redefining jurisdictional areas of the Alaska Soil Conservation Board and would provide for additional board members which would be more likely to represent the needs of the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



Section 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the enactment of SB 120 providing for the amendment of AS 41.10 with full funding.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the Kenai Peninsula Borough is directed to distribute copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz, and Vern Hurlbert, to Senate Resources Committee Chairman Bettye Fahrenkamp, and Committee members, Robert Ziegler, Bob Mulcahy, Richard Eliason, Arliss Sturgulewski, Paul Fischer and Vic Fischer.
