KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-81

GRANTING AN EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC ACCESS AND UTILITY EASEMENTS ACROSS BOROUGH LANDS WITHIN SEC. 9, T3N, R12W, S.M., AND EAST OF COHOE LOOP ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Borough has received patent and final approval of certain Borough selected lands; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a request for a public access and utility easement; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed the request at its meeting of January 24, 1983;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That an easement for public access and utility purposes is granted on the lands described as:

The south 30 ft. of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$;
the south 30 ft. of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ lying easterly of Cohoe Road;
the north 30 ft. of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$;
The north 30 ft. of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ lying easterly of Cohoe Road, all located within Sec. 9, T3N, R12W, S.M.

Section 2. That the portion of the easement to be used for utility purposes is limited to the outer 10 feet of either side of the right-of-way.

Section 3. That an as-built survey shall be submitted to the Borough within 90 days after completion of the proposed right-of-way.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents deemed necessary to effectuate this resolution and in best interests of the Borough.
