RESOLUTION 83-82

AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACTS TO FOUR D INTERIORS, S. RUTHERFORD FLOOR COVERING AND AMSO CARPETS FOR CARPET REPLACEMENT VARIOUS SCHOOLS AND THE EXPENDITURE OF \$84,543.00 OF MAINTENANCE CONTRACT SERVICES MONIES TO FUND THE WORK.

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Department has solicited and opened bids for the priority projects Carpet Replacement Various Schools; and

WHEREAS, Four D Interiors, S. Rutherford Floor Covering and AMSO Carpets have submitted fair and reasonable bids; and

WHEREAS, \$84,543.00 is available in the 1982-83 Maintenance Contract service budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the bids of Four D Interiors to perform all the work required by the contract documents Carpet Replacement Various Schools, Sears Elementary for \$6,561.13 Nikiski Elementary for \$2,059.67, English Bay for \$6,200.00, Kenai Central High for \$8,335.98, Soldotna Jr. High for \$11,437.70, Tustumena for \$8,049.06 and Kenai Jr. High for \$3,621.45; and the bids of S. Rutherford Floor Covering to perform all the work required by the contract documents Carpet Replacement Various Schools, Paul Banks Elementary for \$9,718.00 and Homer High School for \$21,144.00; and that the bid of AMSO Carpet to perform all the work required by the contract document Carpet Replacement Various Schools, Anchor Point Elementary for \$7,415.80 be accepted and contracts awarded.



Section 2. That \$84,543.00 budgeted in the 1982-83 Maintenance Contract Services budget be expended to fund the work.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
