KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 83-98

GRANTING A UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH-OWNED LAND TO HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, the Borough has purchased Lot 1, Block 3, Beluga Bay Estates, Part 2; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a request from Homer Electric Association for a utility easement across this land to install a distribution line; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered the request and recommended the easement to be granted at its April 11, 1983 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That utility easements be granted to Homer Electric Association as follows:

A strip ten (10) feet in width, the southerly line of which is coincident with the southerly line of Lot 1, Block 3 of Beluga Bay Estates Subdivision, Part 2.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of its adoption, and that the Mayor is authorized to execute the authorized easement with such terms and conditions as he deems necessary to preserve the interests and rights of the Borough.
