KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-1

ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO STUDY POSSIBLE ACTIONS OF THE BOROUGH PROTECTING THE KENAI RIVER AND ITS RESOURCES AND COORDINATE THOSE EFFORTS WITH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, the protection of the Kenai River and its resources is of great importance to the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That there is hereby created a special committee of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly to study, propose or make recommendations as to appropriate actions for protecting the Kenai River and its resources.

Section 2. That the committee shall make all efforts to coordinate its efforts and any actions taken by the assembly with efforts of the State of Alaska or any other agencies charged with protecting or managing the Kenai River and its resources.


Section 3. That the committee shall evaluate and make recommendations to the assembly regarding decisions or plans being considered by the state or federal government that would affect the Kenai River and its resources. These evaluations and recommendations shall be made as much in advance of the proposed action as possible so that the assembly may have adequate time to consider the proposals before taking action.


Section 4. That the committee shall consist of no more than seven members of the assembly who shall be appointed by the president of the assembly.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
