RESOLUTION 84-6

TRANSFERRING \$4,025 FROM ASSEMBLY CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT 001.41110 .7400 TO SPECIAL ACTIVITY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING MICROPHONES AND COVERING MICROPHONE AND VOTING PANEL WIRING.

WHEREAS, the Assembly microphones are obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the microphone cables and voting board wiring are exposed under the desks; and

WHEREAS, these wire can be easily kicked and damaged; and


WHEREAS, this has caused erratic functioning of the public address system and voting system;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That \$4,025 be transferred from the Assembly contingency account 001.41110.7400 to special activity equipment account 001.41110.8300 for the purpose of replacing the Assembly microphones, replacing defective wiring, and securing and covering all wiring under the Assembly desks.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
