KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-8

SUPPORTING A DIRECT GRANT FROM THE STATE LEGISLATURE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS DESIGNATED FOR FIRE STATION #1, SALAMATOF AREA.

WHEREAS, the Nikiski Fire Service Area Board of Directors will use the grant funds for site development and remodeling the existing facility; and

WHEREAS, a draft well site needs to be constructed one quarter mile (1/4) from Station #1 on Salamatof Lake to provide a fire suppression water source;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly supports and urges that the legislature of the state of Alaska in its upcoming session in January 1984 to appropriate funds for a grant to the Kenai Peninsula Borough in the amount of \$682,975 for purposes of site development and remodeling of the existing fire station facility at Fire Station #1 in the Salamatof area and construction of a draft well site.


Section 2. That estimated costs of this project are as below and shown in the attached exhibits:
