KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-9

SETTING FORTH REQUESTS OF THE ASSEMBLY FOR LEGISLATIVE ACTION BY THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE AND ESTABLISHING PRIORITIES FOR THE BOROUGH ON THESE REQUESTED ACTIONS

WHEREAS, the Second Session of the Thirteenth Legislature of the State of Alaska will convene in January of 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough finds it in the best interest of the Borough to provide a list of matters of concern to the Borough that require legislative action and recommends action on the following items;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following items are considered to be of the highest priority for action by the Alaska Legislature:


- * Approval of royalty oil contracts with Chevron and Tesoro by the legislature at the earliest possible date.
- * That all steps necessary through the legislative and executive branches be taken to secure the licensing of the Bradley Lake Hydroelectric Project and proceed with all further actions necessary to complete that project.
- * Supporting the action by the State administration and requesting legislative action to protect the Kenai River drainage and its resources.
- * That the State take action to provide full funding for the Homer High School Additive Alternates, and to provide that land essential to the Homer High School, currently occupied by the Department of Transportation, be conveyed to the Borough.
- * Funding for road projects upon which the design work has been completed and also funding for design on new roads.

Section 2. That in addition to the matters listed in this resolution as being of the highest priority, the Legislature is requested to take action upon the requests set forth in Res. 83-227 as previously adopted.

Section 3. That the Borough Clerk shall distribute a copy of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield, Senate President Jalmar Kerttula, to House Speaker Joe L. Hayes, to Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer, and to Representatives Hugh Malone, Bette Cato, Milo Fritz, and Vern Hurlbert, and to the Chairs of the Resource and Finance Committees.


Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon the date of its adoption.
