KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-103

TRANSFERRING BOND FUNDS FROM COMPLETED PROJECTS TO PRIORITY PROJECTS REQUESTED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND TRANSFERRING BOND FUNDS TO AN UNALLOCATED CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education approved the priority #1 projects to be completed with bond funds from completed projects at its March 18, 1984 meeting; and

WHEREAS, contingency funds are available from completed projects at Kalifornsky Beach, Nikiski and Tustumena schools; and

WHEREAS, the projects are proposed to be accomplished in the 1985 construction season provided funds are made available; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to proceed with selection of consultants and the design phases for these projects so that bids may be solicited at the earliest possible time;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the request for the following capital projects by the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District are approved.

- A. Convert the swimming pool in the old Homer High School into a multi-purpose room/cafeteria. Planning funds only. \$ 50,000
- B. Remodel kitchen, replace gym floor, replace fire alarm, replace hall lockers, renovate space for library, renovate restrooms, add blinds to windows, replace carpeting and replace incandescent lighting to convert Homer Middle School to an elementary school. Planning funds only. \$ 50,000
- C. Add twenty (20) feet of asphalt to tennis court at Kenai Central High School in order to convert from two (2) courts to four (4) courts. \$ 20,000
- D. Grade and seed additional practice fields at Kenai Central High School. \$ 25,000

- E. Expand asphalt parking area and asphalt play area & purchase & install fixed Big Toy equipment at Nikiski Elementary School. \$103,000
- F. Complete site development at Sterling School. \$100,000
- G. Develop five (5) acre tract into soccer field, landscaping, and site development at Tustemena. \$ 59,600
- H. Add alternates for paved parking lot and new fire alarm system at Kenai Central High School. \$401,500
- I. Asphalt drive parking lot and path at Homer Middle School. \$318,000


Section 2. That funds totaling \$1,800,000 are transferred from the K-Beach Elementary School Account #401-710500-49999-82156 to the following accounts:

Section 3. That remaining bond funds at Nikiski and Sterling are reassigned as follows:

- A. Expand the asphalt parking & play area & purchase & install fixed Big Toy equipment at Nikiski 401-710800-49999-81161 \$103,000
- B. Complete Site Development at the Sterling School 401-711200-49999-82159 \$100,000
