RESOLUTION 84-108

ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO FORMULATE SENIOR CITIZEN  
ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, in the past the Assembly has appropriated varying amounts as annual grants to senior citizen's programs within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, these funds need to be distributed equitably and with guidelines or formula that is consistent from year to year; and


WHEREAS, better communications among senior programs and the Assembly is desirable to achieve such guidelines;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. There is established a special committee consisting of three assembly members, one representative of the administration from the Finance Dept., and at least one representative from each senior program who would be chosen by their members. The committee may meet as necessary to share information, establish guidelines by September 15, 1984 for future eligibility for funds and develop a formula for allocation of funds to be considered by the Assembly.

Section 2. This resolution takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on July 1, 1984.
