RESOLUTION 84-11

REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES, TO REOPEN THE KENAI MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSING AND REGISTRATION OFFICE AND FULLY STAFF IT.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula is a rapidly expanding population area; and

WHEREAS, the recently closed motor vehicle office located in the city of Kenai was exceedingly busy; and

WHEREAS, the motor vehicle licensing and registration office in Soldotna is the closest facility to the Kenai and Nikiski areas and that office is already exceedingly busy; and

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for reopening of the Kenai motor vehicle licensing office in order to accommodate the needs of the area;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the State of Alaska, Department of Motor Vehicles is urged to reopen the motor vehicle licensing office located in Kenai, Alaska and to fully staff that facility so as to serve the needs of the area.

Section 2. That the clerk shall send copies of this resolution to the Honorable William Sheffield, Governor of the State of Alaska, the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles, Representative Hugh Malone and Senators Don Gilman and Paul Fischer.
