RESOLUTION 84-123

REQUESTING CONSTRUCTION OF A FOUR LANE DIVIDED HIGHWAY BETWEEN THE CITIES OF SOLDOTNA AND KENAI.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Spur Highway is a vital link for commuter traffic between the cities of Soldotna, Kenai and the North Kenai area; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Spur Highway is the main source and route for commercial and industrial transport vitally needed to promote growth and economic development of the area; and

WHEREAS, the increasing population of the central peninsula area has resulted in increasing heavy traffic beyond the safe and efficient capacities of the Kenai Spur Highway; and


WHEREAS, the Kenai Spur Highway is in the state highway system and construction and maintenance responsibilities are therefore vested in the state;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough request the governor to seek authorization and appropriation of the necessary funds to construct a four lane divided highway between Kenai and Soldotna in FY 1985-86.


