RESOLUTION 84-126

CHANGING THE AUTHORIZED EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS FOR THE DATA PROCESSING DEPARTMENT BY DELETING ONE PROGRAMMER ANALYST POSITION AND CREATING ONE ADDITIONAL PROGRAMMER POSITION.

WHEREAS, through Ordinance 84-33 amended, Section 7, the Borough Assembly has authorized the Data Processing Department to hire three (3) employees for the positions of programmer analyst; and

WHEREAS, one (1) programmer analyst position has not yet been filled; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Data Processing Department that the work allotted to one programmer analyst position could be effectively carried out by an employee hired in the position of programmer; and


WHEREAS, the programmer position is for lower salary, requires less experience and can more easily be filled by a qualified applicant from the local area than can the position of programmer analyst;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That Ordinance 84-33 Amended is amended to increase the allocated number of programmer positions by one (1) and to reduce the allocated number of programmer analyst positions from three (3) to two (2).

Section 2. That this resolution is effective immediately upon its adoption.
