RESOLUTION 84-127

REQUESTING THE MAYOR TO SEEK DEDICATION OR A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT FOR A PORTION OF DIANE LANE SO MAINTENANCE CAN BE PROVIDED.

WHEREAS, road maintenance service area funds may only be used if the road is in a dedicated right-of-way or easement; and

WHEREAS, a road known as Diane Lane exists connecting areas along Longmere Lake and the road is heavily traveled by residents of the area and in need of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, there is no dedicated right-of-way or easement for this road; and


WHEREAS, this road is on land owned by the State and considered for selection under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is requested to take such actions as are necessary to seek an easement or dedication of a right-of-way for that portion of Diane Lane in the vicinity of Longmere Lake from the proper persons so that the road can be eligible for maintenance under the road service area maintenance program.


Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
