KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-128 (SUBSTITUTE)

PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO ACQUIRE NON-AREAWIDE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE POWERS.

WHEREAS, the assembly has been made aware of the desire of a significant number of borough residents to receive emergency medical services in areas not now receiving such services; and

WHEREAS, the integration of existing service areas would provide a more efficient system for provision of emergency services through reduction in need for redundant equipment and facilities; and

WHEREAS, areas within first class cities may not be included in the areawide provision of fire and emergency medical services by the borough unless the cities first transfer their power to provide such services to the borough; and

WHEREAS, the assembly finds that emergency medical services are needed throughout the borough and may best and most efficiently be provided by the acquisition of non-areawide emergency medical service powers by the borough; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of non-areawide emergency medical service powers must be approved by a majority of those persons voting within the borough outside of first class cities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition shall be placed before the voters outside cities only at the next regular election on October 2, 1984:

Proposition

"Shall the borough acquire non-areawide powers to provide emergency medical services to all areas of the borough outside of first class cities?"
