KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-130

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR OF ALASKA AND THE FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REIMBURSE THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH FOR FUNDS EXPENDED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HOMER HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the construction of the new Homer High School requires the site acquisition of the existing Homer Highway Maintenance Facility; and

WHEREAS, the new construction of a Homer Highway Maintenance Facility is required before the existing site may be acquired; and

WHEREAS, the construction of a new Homer Highway Maintenance Facility will enhance the highway maintenance operations in the Homer and Anchor Point areas; and


WHEREAS, a budget of \$1,800,000 is required for the construction of a new Homer Highway Maintenance Facility;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly urge the Governor and the Fourteenth Legislature to appropriate sufficient funds in the amount of \$1,800,000 TO reimburse the Kenai Peninsula Borough for funds expended for the Homer Maintenance Facility in order to save some money for the construction of a new Homer Highway Maintenance Facility.

Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk is directed to distribute copies of this resolution to Governor William J. Sheffield and the Department of Transportation, Commissioner Knapp.
