KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 84-131 (SUBSTITUTE)

PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT PROPOSITION FOR THE OCTOBER 2, 1984 REGULAR ELECTION AUTHORIZING INDEBTEDNESS TO APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000,000 (TEN MILLION) FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING A SOLID WASTE INCINERATION PLANT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a proposition shall be placed upon the ballot for the next regular borough election, October 2, 1984 as follows:

Proposition

Authorizing \$10,000,000 In Bonds For A Solid Waste Incineration Facility.

"Shall Ordinance 84-60 be approved to authorize the Kenai Peninsula Borough to incur indebtedness and issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 (ten million) for the purpose of constructing and equipping a solid waste incineration plant and pledging the full faith and credit of the borough for an annual levy of taxes in an amount sufficient to pay the principal and interest on these bonds?"



Section 2. That the abbreviated title of this proposition on the ballot shall read:


Authorizing \$10,000,000 in Bonds for a Solid Waste Incineration Facility.
