KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 84-132 (SUBSTITUTE)

PROVIDING FOR A BALLOT PROPOSITION FOR THE OCTOBER 2, 1984 GENERAL ELECTION TO APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,495,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING, RENOVATING, IMPROVING, AND EQUIPPING THE CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL FACILITY, TO PROVIDE A CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY UNIT, ENCLOSED WALKWAY, DIETARY RENOVATION FREE-STANDING BOILER PLANT AND EMERGENCY SUITE ADDITION AND RENOVATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a proposition shall be placed upon the ballot for the next regular borough election, October 2, 1984, to be voted on in the central Kenai Peninsula hospital service areas, as follows:

Proposition

Authorizing \$6,495,000 In General Obligation Bonds of the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area for Capital Improvements at the Central Peninsula Hospital.

"Shall Ordinance 84-57 be approved to authorize the Kenai Peninsula Borough, to incur indebtedness and issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,495,000, to be used for the purpose of expanding, renovating, improving and equipping the Central Peninsula General Hospital with payment of such indebtedness to be made from taxes levied within the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area, and from such other revenues of the service area as may be properly pledged for such payment; with the full faith and credit of the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area pledged for the repayment of the indebtedness?"


Section 2. That the abbreviated title of this proposition on the ballot shall read:

Authorizing \$6,495,000 in General Obligation Bonds of the Central Peninsula Hospital Service Area for Capital Improvements to the

Central Peninsula Hospital to Include Emergency Suite Addition and Chemical Dependency Unit.


Section 3. That placement of this proposition on the ballot for the October 2, 1984 election is subject to the passage of Ordinance 84-57 by the Borough Assembly.
