KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 84-133 (SUBSTITUTE)

PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL ACQUISITION AND DISTRIBUTION OF 200 TARPS AS A PROGRAM TO ENCOURAGE THE USE OF SUCH TARPS TO COVER GARBAGE THEREBY PREVENTING LITTERING WITHIN THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, trash and other material blown out of vehicles transporting waste materials to the land disposal sites and transfer boxes has created a problem in the borough; and

WHEREAS, this is an unsightly situation and detracts from both the recreational aspects and beauty of the borough; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to seek to encourage persons to cover garbage and materials being hauled to waste disposal sites; and

WHEREAS, the program of providing tarps is part of a promotional scheme for public awareness of the need for covering trash or garbage being transported;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough annually acquire for free distribution 200 tarps as part of a promotional scheme to encourage the use of tarps to cover waste material being transported to our land disposal sites and transfer boxes within the Kenai Peninsula Borough. These tarps shall be distributed at landfill sites or through community service organizations.

Section 2. That such distribution be accompanied by promotional information as to the need and advisability of covering such materials, and that beginning in 1985 distribution shall be made in conjunction with the State sponsored May Cleanup Campaign held annually on the 2nd weekend of May.

Section 3. That the funds for purchase of the tarps shall come from the budget for the landfill and transfer site operations.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately.
